Report on Quiz Competition as part of ongoing 80th Independence Day Celebrations

Government Degree College (GDC) Sumbal organized a highly competitive and intellectually stimulating Quiz Competition as part of its ongoing series celebrating India's landmark 80th Independence Day under the dynamic patronage of the College Principal Prof. (Dr.) Shabeena Iqbal Shawl. The primary objective of the event was to test and enhance students' knowledge regarding the historical journey of the nation. It also aimed to engage the youth productively, aligning with the national Nasha Mukta Bharat initiative to promote healthy, drug-free lifestyles. The quiz was structured around the theme: "**The Freedom Struggle and National Heroes.**" The academic event was smoothly executed through a joint collaboration of three primary student-welfare wings of the college: NSS Wing, NCC Unit and NMBA Committee of the College.

Event Structure & Highlights

- **Preliminary Round:** A written screening test was conducted to filter out the top teams from a massive pool of student entries.
- **Main Stage Quiz:** Four distinct mixed teams (comprising combinations of NCC cadets, NSS volunteers, and general students) qualified for the final stage.
- **Diverse Rounds:** The final event featured rapid-fire rounds, visual identification rounds (recognizing rare photos of freedom fighters), and audio rounds of patriotic speeches.

The scorekeeping and quiz mastering were handled by a panel of senior faculty members to ensure complete transparency.

The event concluded successfully with a collective pledge against drug abuse and the formal signing of the National Anthem. The competition achieved its goal of blending historical education with modern citizenship responsibilities among the students of GDC Sumbal.
