The trip commenced around 10.00 am as the students along with Dr. Fahima Gul and Dr.Syed Shafiya Aalam started the tour towards Mamar in college bus. collection methodology and necessary herbaria techniques to be

followed. Students collected flowering species of Sambucus,

Rannunculus, Taraxacum, Artemesia etc., species from their natural

habitat. In the forest block the students were apprised of ecological

adaptive strategies of *Pinus roxbughii*, *Abeies pindrow Salix* sp and

Taxus sp all native to the Kashmir Himalayas. Students also

identified crustose and foliose lichens in the forest blocks. The trip
